The objective is not only to examine useful tools of analysis, collection, visualization and presentation in the fields of humanities, legal and social sciences, but also to discuss the construction and design of a comprehensive digital research infrastructure for interdisciplinary large-scale research projects.

By discussing several exemplary Digital Humanities projects, the workshop will try to debate the problem of what forms of scientific added value can be expected for research by using different sorts of tools/platforms/IT environments: What novel forms of digital research architectures are utilizable for establishing a digital infrastructure which would decisively advance interdisciplinary – and disciplinary – research projects?
