## Confucian Democracy beyond the Pluralism Dilemma

Sungmoon Kim is Professor of Political Theory at City University of Hong Kong. He received a PhD in political science from the University of Maryland at College Park and previously taught at the University of Richmond. He was a Berggruen fellow at Harvard University's Edmond J. Safra Center for Ethics. Currently, Prof. Kim is also a director of the Center for East Asian and Comparative Philosophy at CityU.

His research interests include democratic and constitutional theory, comparative political theory, Confucianism, and history of East Asian political thought. His essays have been published in journals such as *American Political Science Review* and *Journal of Politics.* 

Kim is the author of Confucian Democracy in East Asia: Theory and Practice (Cambridge University Press, 2014), Public Reason Confucianism: Democratic Perfectionism and Constitutionalism in East Asia (Cambridge University Press, 2016), and Democracy after Virtue: Toward Pragmatic Confucian Democracy (Oxford University Press, 2018).
