



## Travel Grants and Reimbursements for Members of the Graduate Program in European Global Studies

The Graduate Program in European Global Studies specifically aims at integrating its members into the scientific community in Basel and abroad. It encourages its members to engage in scientific activities such as conference and workshop participations and it supports research trips (field work, archival work etc.). For this purpose, each member of the Graduate Program can annually ask for the reimbursement of his or her travel expenses (no more than 200 CHF p.a. and per member of the Graduate Program). Reimbursement claims exceeding the annual quota of 200 CHF will be settled at the end of the year under the condition that there are still funds available.

PhD students funded via a third-party funded project are kindly asked to first try to cover their expenses with their respective project funds.
